ORDER

Before the Bankruptcy Appellate Panel is Appellant, HSBC Bank USA's Motion for a Stay Pending Appeal. Upon consideration of the motion and the objection filed by the Debtor/Appellee, we find that the Movant has failed to establish that it will suffer irreparable injury if the stay is not granted. *Eck v. Dodge Chemical Co. (In re Power Recovery Sys., Inc.)*, 950 F.2d 798, 804 n. 31 (1st Cir. 1991); *In re Miraj & Sons, Inc.*, 201 B.R. 23, 26 (Bankr. D. Mass 1996). Accordingly, the Motion for Stay Pending Appeal is DENIED.
